



Fast Facts

The most significant benefit volunteers receive from volunteering is a genuine sense of satisfaction from helping others. Volunteer opportunities include:

- Fundraising Services – The Highlander Boutique (Gift Shop), popcorn sales, and variety of special sales and events throughout the year.
- Patient Support Services – Emergency Department, Infusion Center, Inpatient and Outpatient Rehab and Pet Therapy. Providing comfort and compassion by assisting patients, their families and visitors with non-clinical needs.
- Reception Services – day surgery desk, registration check-in desk, surgical waiting room desk, and main entrance information desks. Greeting and providing wayfinding assistance to patients and visitors at key entrances at the Medical Centers in Gratiot and Mt. Pleasant.

Milestones

2019 | Opened new state-of-the-art Maternity Center and Cath lab at the Medical Center in Gratiot. Graduated four new family medicine doctors all who stayed local to practice medicine.

2018 | MidMichigan Medical Center - Gratiot accredited as a Level III Trauma Center.

Received a 5 Star Rating for Overall Quality in Medicare.gov's Hospital Compare (December release).

Added new 3D Mammography at MidMichigan Medical Center - Mt. Pleasant.

2017 | MidMichigan Medical Center - Mt. Pleasant opened in February.

At the Medical Center in Gratiot, the Behavioral Health Unit was expanded to 29 private rooms. In addition, new cancer fighting technology and state-of-the-art imaging equipment, including 3D mammography and a linear accelerator was added.

2016 | Commission on Cancer of the American College of Surgeons granted Three-Year Accreditation with Commendation to the cancer program.

2015 | Started a Breast Health Program at the Medical Center in Gratiot. Family Medicine Residency training program established.

2013 | Simulation Center opened at the Medical Center in Gratiot. MidMichigan Health and Michigan Medicine signed an agreement to affiliate.

2012 | Opened Wound Treatment Center.

Installed the only 128-slice CT in Isabella County.

2011 | Gratiot Medical Center renamed MidMichigan Medical Center - Gratiot. Added 182,888 square feet of space, including a state-of-the-art Emergency Department, four-story patient care tower with all private patient rooms and RehabCentre inpatient rehabilitation program that helps patients recover from complex conditions such as stroke.

2005 | The Medical Center in Gratiot became a full subsidiary of MidMichigan Health.

2000 | Opened MidMichigan Gratiot Cancer Center, a joint venture with MidMichigan Medical Center - Midland, providing radiation and medical oncology. MidMichigan Health Park - Mt. Pleasant opened with primary care physicians, specialists, rehabilitation services, radiology, cardiovascular services, and an aquatic therapy pool.
