- IN DEVELOPMENT -

The Naglieri General Ability Tests are comprised of three brand-new tests expressly developed to help identify gifted students fairly and equitably. These tests measure general intellectual ability across **verbal** (Naglieri & Brulles), **nonverbal** (Naglieri), and **quantitative** (Naglieri & Lansdowne) content.

Test items are carefully designed to remove cultural influences, allow students to solve problems regardless of the language they speak, and significantly reduce the amount of formal knowledge required so the tests measure how well students 'think', rather than what students 'know'. Initial research has found minimal differences across gender, race/ethnicity, and parental education level.

The *Naglieri General Ability Tests* online portal automatically scores students' performance using local norms, providing school system stakeholders with multiple score options at the click of a button.
