Allentown Downstown Streetscape Improvement

- This project included full reconstruction of all sidewalks, curbs, ADA accessible ramps, and decorative amenities which were chosen through close work with the Borough's Historic Streetscape Committee.
- The Pharmacy Storefront area, which was extremely unsafe, was revitalized with a unique tiered ramp and steps surrounded by bollards with chains to comply fully with ADA Regulations.
- Sidewalks were replaced with a combination of concrete and brick pavers, which were used in the design of ribbons or edging and driveways were improved to match. This design was constructed in conjunction with a past project that enhanced the dam/bridge sidewalk.
- Our Construction Inspector on site, played a vital role in examining the contractor's work and assured that the handicap ramps, sidewalk cross slope and driveway cross slope that were built and met the latest ADA requirements. An inspection report was kept daily along with a diary, and photographs with comments throughout construction.
