- Shatter shield or Coated Lamps (all sizes)
- UV Lamps (all sizes)
- Halogen
- U-bend
- Flood Lamps
- Incandescent
- Circular



Improper fluorescent lamp disposal:

Fluorescent lamps contain mercury that is released as poisonous vapors if the tubes are broken. The mercury from one tube can pollute the air for miles and return to earth to pollute our water and land. Mercury can also be absorbed through the skin by handling broken fluorescent tubes. For these reasons, care must be taken to dispose of fluorescent tubes safely and properly.
