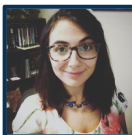

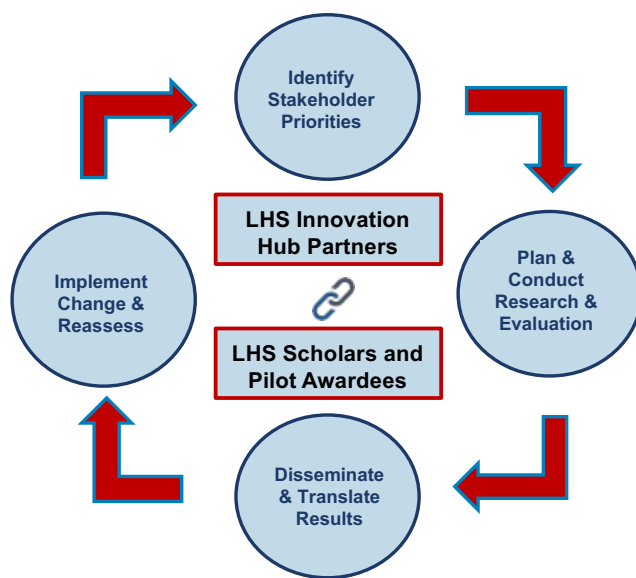

What is a Learning Health System (LHS)?

A LHS systematically integrates evidence established with internal data and real-world experience in order to provide high quality, safer, more efficient care.

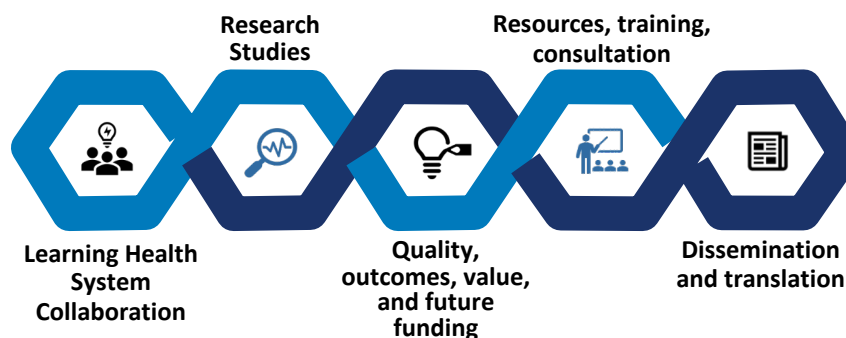


Who Are LHS Researchers?

Individuals embedded within a health system that collaborate with its stakeholders to produce novel insights and evidence that can be rapidly implemented to improve the outcomes of individuals and populations and health system performance.

What is LeaRRn?

LeaRRn is an NIH-funded rehabilitation research resource center that provides support for implementation science and learning health systems research to improve rehabilitation quality, value, and outcomes.
