- Leading the way in outcomes, our pathway gets patients back home 29% more quickly than the national average for length of stay, and with no increase in complications and high patient satisfaction.*
- Vastly improving spine surgical site infection rates at 3.56% in our hospitals compared to a national average of 5.93%.*
- On the forefront of cutting-edge technology and surgical techniques, such as using 3D navigation for complex spine reconstruction.
- Establishing best practices nationally through ongoing collaboration and research.
- Optimizing patient outcomes through technology, including creating a patented device to enhance safety while improving rotational deformity correction in the spine.
