


Unique Considerations When Caring for Preterm Infant Skin



• **Preterm infants** have underdeveloped skin (Figure 1) that is thinner and has less mechanical strength than Full-Term infant skin (Figure 2). • This makes **Preterm skin more permeable to** water and irritants (such as urine and feces) than the skin of a Full-Term infant.^{2, 3, 4, 5, 6}

pH-Balanced Formula


