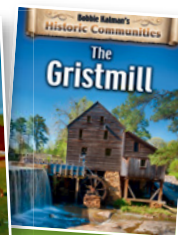
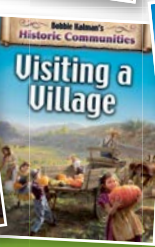
Grateful for so much!

A BRIDGE TO RACE RELATIONS

The snap, crackle, and pop of breakfast was put on hold. Stevie Wonder was up next on the American children's TV series Sesame Street. Stevie and his entire band were there to perform his hit song "Superstition."

A group of school-age children shook maracas, banged their tambourines, and danced. The producers were deliberately showing ethnic diversity. It was 1973 and the U.S. was still adapting to integrated schools, where Black and White children learned together.

Stevie Wonder was the biggest musical act to perform on the show up to that point. He R&B, funk, and jazz-infused sound helped win Stevie a new fan base. With crossover hits such as "For Once in My Life," "Living for the City," and "My Cherie Amour," Stevie Wonder became a bridge to closer race relations between Black and White people.

"If we don't correct the things that keep us in a certain place we will not move forward."

Little Stevie Wonder from Saginaw, Michigan had come a long way. Though visually impaired at birth, Stevie had never thought of himself as being disabled. He went from being a harmonica-playing eleven-year-old to the musical hitmaker, Stevie Wonder.

Raising Animals

Many people eat meat. The animals that provide meat are raised on farms.

Long ago, people hunted animals to eat. Many people still do this, but most meat now comes from farms. Farmers raise cows, pigs, chickens, sheep, and goats. Some farms raise ostriches or bison! Farmers feed and take care of the animals until the animals are ready to be eaten.

In some parts of the world, farmers use animals instead of tractors to pull plows.

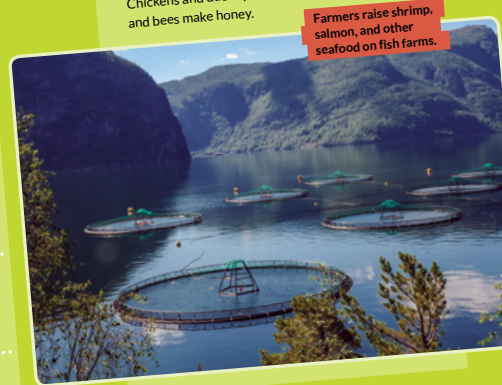
Farmers raise about **50 billion** chickens for eating every year. That's nearly **6 1/2** chickens for every person in the world.

An average dairy cow can produce more than **1,900 gallons** (7,000 l) of milk in a year.

More than Meat

We raise farm animals for other reasons too. Cows and other animals, such as goats, produce milk. We drink milk and also make it into cheese, ice cream, and yogurt. Chickens and ducks produce eggs, and bees make honey.

Farmers raise shrimp, salmon, and other seafood on fish farms.

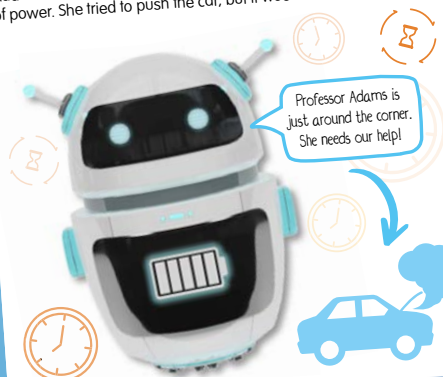

You definitely need your head. It contains your brain, which is in charge of your body. You need your mouth and nose for eating and breathing. When people lose their heads, it's bad news.

That's why, long ago, people were beheaded as a way of executing them.

But cockroaches are a bit different...

Meet the cockroach! There are thousands of cockroach species, and only a few of them invade human homes. This is one of them, the German cockroach.

Cockroaches are insects, and have six legs.

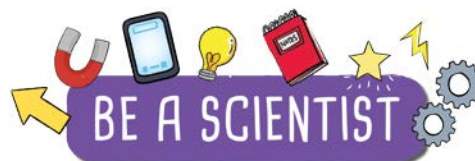
Life without a head

If, for example, a bird bites off a cockroach's head, it really CAN survive—for a while. That's because a cockroach's body works differently than ours in several ways:

- 1 Cockroach blood isn't under high pressure like ours. If the head is pulled off, the neck doesn't leak blood. It just heals up.
- 2 Cockroaches don't breathe through their mouths. They take in air through holes on their bodies, called spiracles. So they can still breathe!
- 3 A cockroach has a brain in its head, but it also has smaller mini-brains, called ganglia, along its body. The ganglia control its legs and organs, so it can live without its main brain.
- 4 Cockroaches do need to eat and drink, and that is their downfall. They can go without food for a month or so, but they can only manage without water for about a week. So that's how long a headless cockroach can live.

Creepy cockroach facts!

- A cockroach can hold its breath underwater for 30 minutes.
- Cockroaches give off a stinky smell.
- To run fast, cockroaches stand up on their back legs!
