## *Nature Reviews Methods Primers*

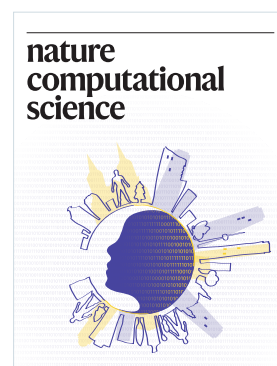
*Nature Reviews Methods Primers* launches in response to increased interest in interdisciplinary research & reproducibility.
