







- ✓ Reported on kids' site registrations at a local level







### Kids' Site Analytics – English Audience Overview June 15 – September 2









## Kids' Site Analytics- French Audience Overview June 15 – September 2

Since joining the Club, I have been reading (by myself or with others)...








## **Kids Survey Results**

Since I joined the Club, I enjoy reading...








# **Kids Survey Results**

Being a part of the Club allowed me to connect and share with other kids....








# Parent/Caregiver Survey Results

My child is a more confident reader.








# Parent/Caregiver Survey Results

My child was able to find books that reflected their identity and experiences.


