- Faculty can establish an evolving digital syllabus by easily organizing, contextualizing, and presenting relevant course materials to students.
- Course creators benefit from the dynamic reading lists that can be changed at any point during the semester, including rolling over lists to following years, so updates can be made to newer versions while retaining previous versions for past students' reference.
- Flexible list building tools allow the user to structure lists in a way that works for their teaching style. Features such as importance and study guidance notes allow faculty to direct their students' study within the application.
- Analytics and reporting on student use of the reading list allow faculty to better understand how course resources are being used, allowing them to amend courses based on previous usage analytics.
- Talis Aspire enables more streamlined copyright compliance workflows when resources are added to lists.
- Faculty can embed lists into their LMS pages to provide easier access to all course material in one place. Additionally, individual sections of a list can also be embedded at any point to allow for bite-sized study, or more directed teaching.
