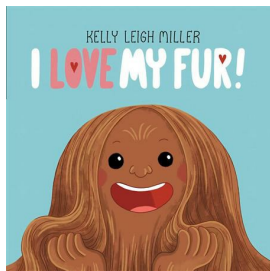

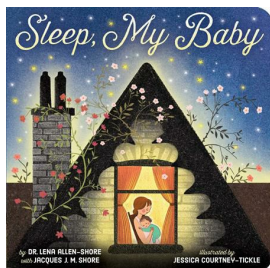
In this delightful follow-up to *I Love My Fangs!*, a little Bigfoot learns that while it's important to love yourself, sharing that love is what truly matters.
