If you could go back, who would you want to meet?

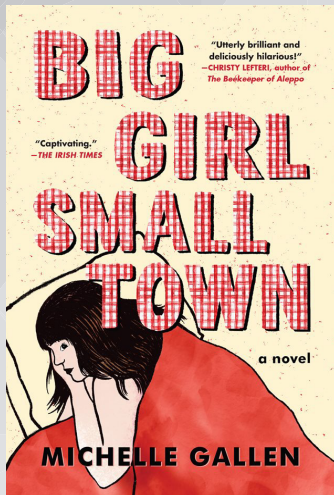
