AWARDS

The Prize:

- 2000 CHF (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Nutrients* after peer review before the end of December 2022;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must be below 35 years of age and have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 30 September 2021;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of Nutrition and Dietetics;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Nomination deadline: 30 September 2021;
- Winners announcement: 30 November 2021.
