IBCLC Examination Eligibility Criteria



- Health science subjects: via recognised clinical health profession or 14 subject courses, AND
- Human lactation and breastfeeding: 95 hours, including 5 hours of education focused on communication skills, within 5 years prior to application, AND

Lactation-Specific Clinical Practise (choose one Pathway and complete all clinical hours within the 5 years prior to application)

- Pathway 1: 1,000 hours in an appropriate supervised setting, OR
- Pathway 2: 300 hours of directly supervised lactation-specific clinical practise at an accredited lactation academic programme, OR
- Pathway 3: 500 hours in mentorship with an IBCLC pre-verified by IBLCE
