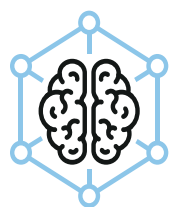

Others will be highlighted in workshops or poster exchanges. Your research will be viewed by an interdisciplinary audience of 2000+ clinicians from around the world.
- All abstracts are published in ASPEN's premier *Journal of Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition (JPEN)*.
- Multiple research awards are available, including: The Harry M. Vars Award, Promising Investigator

Award, Research Trainee Awards, Best of the ASPEN Nutrition Science & Practice Conference Awards, International Abstract Research Awards, Research Workshop Travel Awards, and Abstracts of Distinction.
