THE MAYO CLINIC ACGME-ACCREDITED PM&R RESIDENCY PROGRAM will prepare you for a career in private practice, research, or academic medicine. The program features:

- A diverse curriculum covering injection techniques, clinical practice pearls, and diagnostic/management of disorders seen in a physical medicine and rehabilitation practice.
- A learning environment that fosters the development of your clinical skills and academic abilities in all areas of rehabilitation medicine.
- A balance between outpatient and inpatient rehabilitation experience, including subspecialty rehabilitation programs, electromyography, neurology, and research.
- Extensive EMG and musculoskeletal medicine training, including ultrasound.

- A large, diverse patient population and close working relationships with a large staff of physiatrists.
- The opportunity to form collegial relationships with experts in many related medical and surgical specialties.
