

SAFE POTABLE WATER BLADDERS

AIRE Environmental potable water bladders start as rolls of NSF/ANSI/CAN 61 certified fabric. To obtain this level of certification, the fabric is subjected to rigorous testing to ensure that it won't release harmful levels of toxic chemicals into water under normal use.

We further protect our clients by welding each seam, eliminating the need for adhesives that are both unreliable and might release chemicals themselves.

When you buy an AIRE Environmental Potable Water Bladder, you can be sure that the water you store in it will still be safe to drink when you're ready for it.
