Medium Stream Spray

- Medium Stream is our most popular spray
- Produces a pinpoint stream
- Anesthetizes the skin at a specific location
- Ideal for procedures such as:
IV starts, blood draws, injections, incision and drainage of small abscesses, suturing and suture removal

Mist Spray

- Mist may be appropriate for broader application sites
- Causes a more intense cooling effect than Medium Stream spray due to faster evaporation
- Mist is more appropriate for facial applications



Important Risk and Safety Information for Gebauer's Pain Ease:

Consult your pediatrician when using on children 4 years old and younger. Do not use on large areas of damaged skin, puncture wounds, animal bites or serious wounds. Do not spray in eyes.
