It is the pediatric hospital for Albert Einstein College of Medicine, an outstanding academic institution dedicated to research and medical education.

Since 2001, our purpose has been to provide children with the best opportunity to lead active and healthy lives and fully realize their potential. We bring together some of the world's leading pediatric specialists and child health investigators to ensure that we deliver the highest quality healthcare with compassion and sensitivity.

A Continuum of Pediatric Care

Each year, we care for more than 8,000 hospitalized infants, children and adolescents with complex medical and surgical conditions, including 1,100 patients in our state-of-the-art pediatric critical care unit and approximately 1,000 critically ill newborns in our neonatal intensive care units. Almost 200,000 children receive treatment through our pediatric ambulatory care programs, and an additional 44,000 children are treated in a school-based health program.





Research & Innovation

As the pediatric hospital for our Albert Einstein College of Medicine, groundbreaking discoveries by CHAM investigators have led to new therapies, safer processes and better outcomes for children treated worldwide. CHAM has received significant recognition and funding for our clinical and laboratory-based research with grants and contracts of more than \$39 million in 2021 alone. Of that sum, \$19 million was awarded by the National Institutes of Health (NIH). CHAM is in the top 35 institutions receiving national funding for pediatric diseases from NIH.
