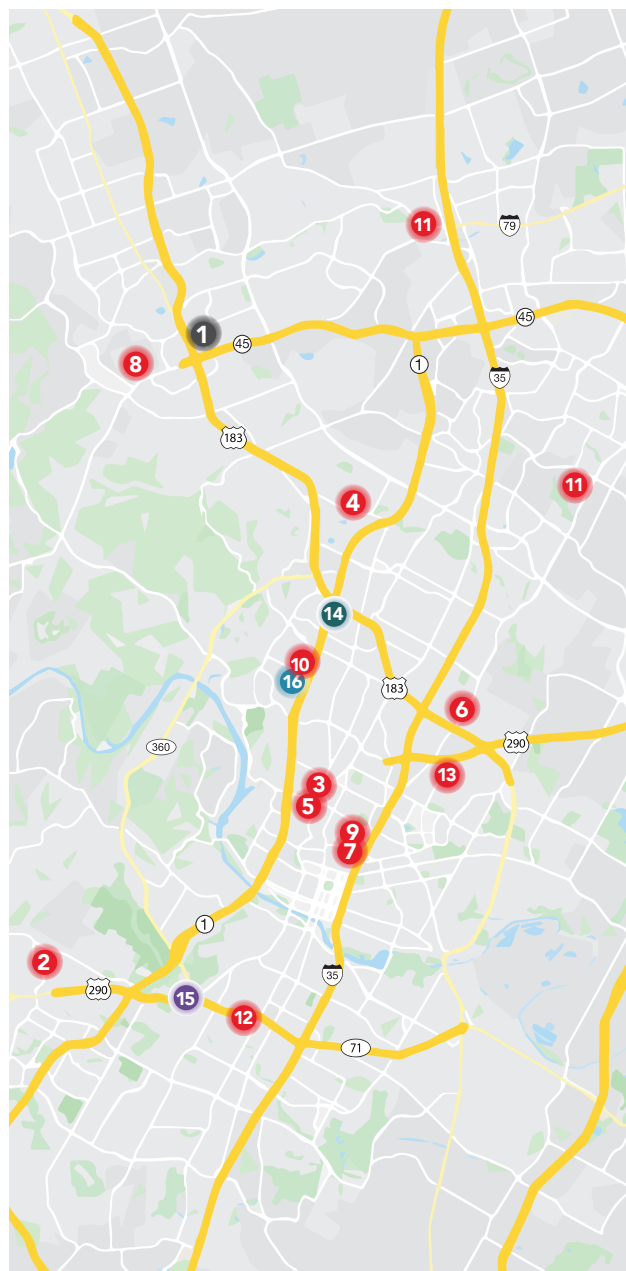

The differentiators

Texas Children's Hospital provides world-class pediatric patient care, education and research at its flagship hospital in the Texas Medical Center, its two community hospitals, and its network of specialty care locations. The Texas Medical Center campus provides the highest level of care including a Level IV neonatal intensive care unit, a Level I trauma center, pediatric and cardiac intensive care units, a dedicated Adult Congenital Heart inpatient unit and cutting edge surgical, medical, diagnostic and therapeutic services.

Texas Children's Pavilion for Women provides full-spectrum services and specialties for women and their babies in one central location. From routine obstetrics and gynecology services to pioneering a two-port fetoscopic procedure to treat spina bifida that has now been used in seven countries around the world, our team of maternal, fetal and pediatric specialists are setting new standards in their fields.

Texas Children's Heart Center is home to pediatric cardiology and cardiovascular surgery programs ranked no. 1 for five consecutive years. The center provides comprehensive care for patients with congenital heart disease and other cardiac anomalies, including arrhythmia surveillance, cardiovascular genetic testing and research, cardiac intensive care, congenital heart surgery, echocardiography/fetal echocardiography, electrophysiology, minimally invasive surgery and heart transplantation. The center provides unparalleled care for patients from conception to adulthood through its fetal, pediatric and Adult Congenital Heart programs.

Texas Children's Neuroscience Center is a comprehensive destination for children suffering from common neurological conditions like epilepsy and muscular dystrophy to more complex and rare disorders like lissencephaly and Rett Syndrome. The center is leading research, treatment and surgical intervention for the full continuum of pediatric neurological conditions. As one of the largest programs of its kind in the nation, Texas Children's Neuroscience Center provides lifesaving treatments for thousands of critically ill children every year.

Texas Children's Cancer and Hematology Center, one of the largest in the U.S., offers expertise in all aspects of pediatric cancer and blood disorders — from bone marrow and stem cell transplants to immune hepatology and cancer genetics. The Center also operates Global HOPE, the first and only initiative focused on building long-term capacity to treat and dramatically improve the prognosis for children with cancer and blood disorders in Sub-Saharan Africa.



Future state in Austin

Texas Children's is building a children's and women's hospital in Austin. Scheduled to open in 2024, it will become part of the robust network of Texas Children's services already in Austin, including pediatric primary care, urgent care, specialty care and Maternal Fetal Medicine. The new \$485 million top-tier children and women's hospital is being built for the future, and brings advanced care to a city that's helping move the world forward.
