

- CHAM's Lead Poisoning Treatment & Prevention Program is the oldest and most comprehensive program of its kind, creating the science that has set the standards for lead poisoning levels by the EPA

- The first New York City health system to earn a national distinction for behavioral health from the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA)
