Other Facts

Medicaid

- In 2020, 75% of children treated by Valley Children's were covered by Medicaid (Medi-Cal in California).
- The average for children's hospitals nationally is 50% and for children's hospitals in California 64%.

Physician Supply and Training

- Most of Valley Children's service area is designated as a Health Professional Shortage Area by the federal government for primary care physicians, including pediatricians.
- In 2020, Valley Children's trained 31 medical students and 201 physician residents affiliated with 19 different medical education programs.
- That same year we received \$606,887 in CHGME funding, covering about 14% of our total physician training costs of just over \$4.3 million.
