

#### **Hemodialysis Access Intervention**

Dialysis Access Angiography and/or IVUS · Dialysis Access Stent/Stent Graft Placement Dialysis Access Catheter Removal • Dialysis Access Embolization/Injection Therapy Dialysis Access Catheter Placement or Revision • Dialysis Access Angioplasty Percutaneous Arteriovenous Access Creation/Insertion Treatment of Dialysis Access Thrombosis via Thrombolysis/Thrombectomy

### **Peripheral Arterial Intervention**

Angiography • Stent Placement • Thrombectomy • Arterial Angioplasty • Atherectomy Cerebrovascular Therapy • Endovascular Aorta Repair (EVAR) • IVUS Embolization Therapy (Endoleak, AVM, Peripheral/Mesenteric Aneurysm)

#### **Deep Venous Intervention**

Invasive Diagnostic Testing (Venography/Intravascular Ultrasound [IVUS]) Venous Angioplasty and/or Stenting • Treatment of Pelvic Venous Reflux Inferior Vena Cava Filter Retrieval/Repositioning • Inferior Vena Cava Filter Placement Treatment of Venous Malformation • Invasive Treatment of Deep Vein Thrombosis

IAC Standards & Guidelines have been established to provide guidance in training and experience, protocol development and resources needed to perform these procedures. All three Standards were published in June 2022. By achieving IAC accreditation, facilities will demonstrate their commitment to high quality patient care.
