Hemodialysis Access Intervention

Dialysis Access Angiography and/or IVUS • Dialysis Access Stent/Stent Graft Placement
Dialysis Access Catheter Removal • Dialysis Access Embolization/Injection Therapy
Dialysis Access Catheter Placement or Revision • Dialysis Access Angioplasty
Percutaneous Arteriovenous Access Creation/Insertion
Treatment of Dialysis Access Thrombosis via Thrombolysis/Thrombectomy

Peripheral Arterial Intervention

Angiography • Stent Placement • Thrombectomy • Arterial Angioplasty • Atherectomy
Cerebrovascular Therapy • Endovascular Aorta Repair (EVAR) • IVUS
Embolization Therapy (Endoleak, AVM, Peripheral/Mesenteric Aneurysm)

Deep Venous Intervention

Invasive Diagnostic Testing (Venography/Intravascular Ultrasound [IVUS])
Venous Angioplasty and/or Stenting • Treatment of Pelvic Venous Reflux
Inferior Vena Cava Filter Retrieval/Repositioning • Inferior Vena Cava Filter Placement
Treatment of Venous Malformation • Invasive Treatment of Deep Vein Thrombosis

IAC Standards & Guidelines have been established to provide guidance in training and experience, protocol development and resources needed to perform these procedures.

All three *Standards* were published in June 2022. By achieving IAC accreditation, facilities will demonstrate their commitment to high quality patient care.
